Online Counselling for Special Categories

(PwD/Defence/Freedom Fighter/Kashmiri Migrants/ J & K)

Online counseling for admission against supernumerary seats (please see annexure-I) for candidates belonging to categories of Persons with Disability, widows/wards of armed forces personnel, wards of freedom fighters, riot affected, wards of Kashmiri migrants, candidates from Jammu and Kashmir will be conducted on 27th July, 2016.

All the Candidates who appeared in CUCET-2016 examination, submitted the Online Counselling Form of Central University of Punjab and claimed reservation against above categories will be eligible to participate in the online counseling as per the following schedule.

Online counselling will be divided into two steps. In first step, candidates will be offered seats for locking their preference and each candidate will be able to lock one preference between 8 AM-11 AM. Among the locked choices, merit will be prepared for each programme and candidate(s) with higher merit will be offered the seat for fee submission as per availability of seats.

Candidates need to login to their Web portal (http://www.cup.edu.in/admission_counseling/users/dashboard) with the Username and password they are registered with. Candidates will be able to lock their preference between 8-11 AM and will be required to submit the fee (if offered seat) between 2-6 PM to secure the allotted seat. In case the candidate fails to deposit the fee within the stipulated date & time, his/her seat will be declared vacant.

	Fee submission 27th July 2 PM to 6 PM	Programme wise seats will be offered as per merit drawn among the candidates who locked their preference for respective programme. Candidates who have been offered seats will be required to submit the fee between 2 PM to 6 PM.
